## FF No.1 MONOBATH DEVELOPER

## **Directions for Use**

version 1 (Jan/2018)

Wear gloves and eye protection, and always use FF No.1 in a well-ventilated space. For best results with 35mm, 120 and 4x5 sheet films, use a daylight tank.

- After loading your exposed negatives, quickly pour the monobath at room temperature (70-72°F or 21-22°C) into the daylight tank. Ensure the film is completely covered by the monobath fluid. Agitate using the inversion method for a total time of 6 minutes: invert and revert for the first minute continuously (6 to 10 inversion cycles is quite sufficient); then invert once or twice at each subsequent 30-second interval.
- 2) After 6 minutes, pour the monobath back into its container. Then rinse the negatives thoroughly in room-temperature water for 5 minutes.
- 3) Hang the negatives in a dust-free environment to dry.

FF No.1 may be used again and again. The 1-Liter bottle develops about 400 square inches of film; the 500ml bottle, about half as much:

35mm	7 rolls	4 rolls
120	8 rolls	6 rolls
4x5	20 sheets	12 rolls
