Proper Care Instructions

Do not drop plexiglass bath interior. Plexiglass is strong and properly sealed, but if dropped can crack making it unusable.

Do not allow wet chemicals to sit on the wood or hardware. Wipe down any chemicals spilled on the hardware and wood after each use. We also suggest putting the bath inside a tray to keep it dry from spills during use.

Do not store chemicals in the bath. Empty bath after each use, and rinse plexiglass interior to remove chemical residue.

When removing the interior bath for rinsing make sure to wipe the outside completely dry before putting it back in the wood enclosure. Failure to do so can cause damage to the wood

Operating instructions

Pouring chemicals in - Do not remove interior plexiglass bath. Lean bath back on kickstand and use a funnel to pour in chemicals.

Pouring chemicals out - Hold full bath (with the wooden exterior) and pour chemicals straight out into storage container. Secure plexiglass interior by holding it to keep it from falling out while pouring.

To rinse - Pull out removable plexiglass interior. Rinse and dry before putting back into the wooden enclosure.
